Smart Irrigation Controller

Little Thompson Water District recommends EPA WaterSense®-labeled smart irrigation controllers to help reduce overwatering. These controllers automatically adjust watering schedules based on weather, soil conditions, and plant needs, ensuring water is applied only when and where it is needed.

Residential outdoor water use in the United States totals nearly 8 billion gallons per day, and experts estimate that more than 50% is wasted due to inefficient irrigation practices. Smart irrigation controllers are an effective way to improve efficiency and reduce unnecessary water use.

Caring for a Water-Wise Lawn

A healthy lawn can also be water-efficient when managed properly

-  - Mow higher. Keep grass at least 3 inches tall to shade soil, reduce evaporation, and promote deeper root growth.
-  - Water at the right time. Water before 10 a.m. or after 6 p.m. to minimize evaporation and wind loss.
-  - Follow watering schedules. Only water on your assigned watering days and check the current action level meter to determine allowable watering frequency.



More than half of household water use happens outdoors. By designing landscapes with healthy soils, water efficient plants, and efficient irrigation systems, homeowners can significantly reduce water use.

Finding a Smart Irrigation Controller

Your landscape contractor, local nursery, or home and garden store can help you select a smart irrigation controller that fits your landscape needs. When purchasing, look for the EPA WaterSense® label to ensure the controller meets water-efficiency standards and may qualify for rebates.

Required to receive rebate up to \$125 (excludes sales tax and delivery fees):

- Attach ***detailed, itemized*** receipt to this form clearly showing the manufacturer, model, and cost of smart irrigation controller
- Attach before and after photos of installed smart irrigation controller
- Take a photo of mandatory watering schedule programmed into the smart irrigation controller
- Program your smart controller to the mandatory watering days based on the action level at the time of installation. The action level table with the mandatory watering days can be found on LTWDs website at <https://littlethompsonwd.colorado.gov/>.
- Download the Eye On Water App and provide the water usage from the 5th of the previous month
